Range Issues Unfortunately, Association members continue to be harassed while using the ranges on the east side of Fish & Game Road. If you are harassed while using our ranges, the EBFG BOD requests that you: 1 - stay calm, 2 - DO NOT approach, incite or antagonize the person harassing you, 3 - get a picture of the individual harassing you, 4 - get a picture of the vehicle involved (if you video record the incident you MUST inform the parties involved you are recording the incident), 5 - dial 911 and tell the operator you are being harassed, required **State Police** at the location (1808 Fish & Game Road, East Berlin) and you are in Adams County - the police will respond! Get a police report number if possible. After the incident, contact the club president to recount the incident. The BOD needs to establish a history of incidents to formulate an effective response. If you have any questions or concerns, contact the Association president. These harassment issues will be addressed.

Please. call the State Police if you are harassed while on Association property - get a police incident/report number - The Board of Directors cannot effectively respond to these issues without verifiable evidence of the incident. Don't just complain, help the Board of Directors get these issues resolved - it's your club, get involved!

Electronic Communictions 2023 will be the year that East Berlin Fish and Game, Inc. steps into the electronic age. Look for more Association information delivered electronically and/or available on the Association website.

The first attempt at newsletter email delivery was a moderate success. With the membership database in transition, a complete list of members email addresses does not yet exist. As the membership data integrity improves, electronic delivery of the newsletter will improve. 337 electronic copies of the newsletter were sent out, 60 duplicate addresses were removed from the roster and 509 paper copies were mailed. This effort saved the club approximately \$115 in processing fees and postage. Once the newsletter delivery is optimal, electronic communications will move into alerts, Association news, event flyers, club activities, etc.

Please get familiar with the website as it will be the place to go for breaking news, upcoming events, status on current activities and points of interest.
