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Membership Definitions and Guidelines

Membership – Active membership of the Association shall consist of male and female citizens who are legally qualified to hunt and/or fish, who have reached their 18th birthday, and satisfy all membership requirements.

New Member/Reinstatement - \$20.00 Initiation Fee plus current membership dues (\$60.00). Annual membership is a January to December period, with no partial or pro-rated memberships. All new members must pass a background check.

Life Member – A member of the association for 10 years (not necessarily consecutive) and who has either served as an officer or a director for at least two of those years, and is at least 62 years of age. A life member is dues free.

Senior Member – A member with the club for 10 years (not necessarily consecutive) and has reached the age of 62. Fees for senior members is \$10.00.

Junior Members – Shall consist of male and female citizens who are legally qualified to hunt and/or fish, between the ages of 8 and 17. Junior members will be eligible to be considered an Active Member when they reach their 18th birthday. There is no dues required for Junior Membership.

Military Members – Shall consist of male and female citizens currently enlisted in the armed forces. Proof of active duty is required for new members. There is no dues required for Military Membership.

Renewals - Renewals for membership begin October 1 and run through the final general membership meeting in December (the third Thursday of the month). Failure to renew during this period will require a new background check and initiation fee.

Full Membership rules and regulations are in the Member's Handbook.

Membership Process

Membership paperwork is received by Membership Secretary and reviewed for completeness. Prospective member is read-in (proposed) to membership at next available General Membership Meeting (third Thursday of the month). Background check is completed. Prospective members will only be contacted if there is an issue with the application. If no issues are found, member will be voted upon at the following general meeting. **Member must be present to receive membership card, rules and regulations booklet, facilities key and attend orientation.**
